Trudy was a woman of strength and many thought of her as a saint for all that she accomplished raising her 10 children, for the prayers and support she gave to all and a saint because everything she did, she did with love. Trudy had a big heart and welcomed everyone into her home with love and kindness. There was always

room at the dinner table for others to join and Trudy always had a bowl of freshly baked cookies to share. She was a favorite Aunt amongst her nieces and nephews. Her grand-kids adored her, they knew there was always ice-cream at Grandma's house and they loved the many afternoons spent with Grandma by the pool. In 2013 Trudy moved to Santa Clarita with her daughter and remained there until her passing.

Trudy was a devout Catholic and with every child, the nurse would place the newborn in her arms, Trudy would always thank God for this beautiful precious gift and say a little prayer, "And now God, I give this gift back to you. I promise to love and to care for this child, in your name, all the days of my life". Now, the time has come for us to give our Mom back to God. We thank you Lord for this beautiful precious gift that was bestowed upon us and ask by your grace, that Trudy will eternally be loved, and taken care of, just as Mom took care of her children and loved all of her grandchildren.
