It is with great sadness that the family of Louis J. Kridelbaugh announces his unexpected passing on January 9, 2020 at the age of 75. He was born in Los Angeles on July 14, 1944, son of Louis and Marcella Kridelbaugh. He is survived by his sisters Terri LaMasa and Kathy Grant and many family and friends.

Lou graduated North Hollywood High School in 1962. In 1966 he joined the Air Force and served until 1970. Upon his return he attended Cal State University Northridge where he earned a BS in Business Administration in 1974. After graduating he worked as a regional manager for several publishing companies. For 5 years he served as president of the Gen. Doolittle Chapter of the Air Force Association.

Photography was a passion he shared with loved ones by capturing special moments on file. He enjoyed following various forms of racing and traveled near and far to attend races. Honoring his mother and others, he participated both as a walker and crew for the Avon and Susan G. Komen 60 mile walks. He made many friends being a member of the Wings Over Wendy's Association.
