“ I first met Shannon back in 2004. I was asked to come down from Canada to provide tech support for a SOX project that her team was working on at Southern California Edison. There was a bit of a learning curve but I enjoyed the work and just loved the cast of characters that I got to work with - both co-workers and client. I was scheduled to be on the project for a couple months.

As my time in Rosemead wound down, my resource manager in Canada lined me up for my next project.

I hadn't had much opportunity to interact with Shannon up to that point but one day she called me over to chat. I remember she asked me was if I wanted to go back. This struck me as strange - since starting in consulting, no one had ever asked me what I wanted before. Then she followed it up by saying that I didn't have to go back if I didn't want to. I remember cautiously answering that I would prefer to stay.

In reality, I was dreading going back. The project manager I was slated to work with was/is an ***hole and I think I would have sooner volunteered to be the first person to explore the vacuum of space without a suit than work with him again.

A few days later, Dave White pulled me aside and mentioned that Shannon had called my project manager to discuss my staying on. As Dave told it, my project manager proceeded to immediately give Shannon attitude. Big mistake on his part! The end result - I stayed in Rosemead. A side benefit - I never worked with that project manager again.

Andy Strasner once told me that Shannon is great at making things right. That was the first time I got to experience that.

I know at the time I thanked Shannon but I'm sure I didn't thank her enough. It was more than just not having to work with someone I didn't want to. It kind of solidified my association with what became

the UCG team, where I spent the better part of seven years (on and off). The stability of that organization and the quality of people within it were in no small part due to Shannon's vision and efforts. It was such a privilege for me to get to know and work with that team.

Also, thank you for putting up with my singing at the annual company gatherings. It only ever took a couple of drinks to get me going. I guess you really couldn't complain since you were buying...
